- **iii)** The new accountability survey will now be due at the end of June, to better implement the desired changes in September, rather than further into the school year. The Following was taken verbatim from the <u>Alberta Government Services</u> page: The Alberta funding system for K-12 education has 3 parts or "pillars"; equitable funding, flexibility, accountability. The accountability pillar: Gives schools and school arthritis a consistent way to measure their progress using 16 measures. Helps identify areas for improvement and set priorities for the future. Gives schools and school authorities a wide range of performance data. Focuses on more than results from student tests; giving a more complete view of the school system and how it can improve.

School Advancement Plan Budget

We ask parents and staff to advocate for our school, for even with the split classes our students are able to attain some of the highest matriculation statistics in the Northern Gateway Public School division.
