Message from the Principal

It is hard to believe that we are nearing the end of the first month of 2023!! Students and staff have transitioned well back into learning after the winter break. We have been fortunate to have quite a mild January and have been enjoying skating and outdoor play time.

Mr. Tavaroli and I did a presentation to the Board of Trustees at the annual Results Review in November. One of the aspects we reported on was the SCS Provincial Achievement Test (PAT) results for grades six and nine students. Our results for the 2021-2022 school year were tremendous and we are extremely proud of our students. SCS results exceeded the provincial average in all four subject areas in both grade six and grade nine. This is just one piece of data that illustrates the exceptional teaching and learning at SCS!

Mathematics teachers have been working with learning services coordinator, Meagen Vesely, to continue to develop their capacity as numeracy teachers. Each teacher works directly with Mrs. Vesely and other mathematics teachers who teach the same grade in Northern Gateway Public Schools to gain their expertise in the area of mathematics instruction. We are fortunate to work with Mrs. Vesely as we continue to build capacity in the area of numeracy.
