Domain: Student Growth and Achievement

Division Outcome: Learners achieve acceptable and excellence standards in curricular outcomes.

Goal #1: By June 2026, we will see student improvement in literacy through student's ability to image and infer.

Strategies:

- CTM Meetings
- Empowering Writers used as a school wide writing program that follows scope and sequence
- Cross Grade collaboration and timetabling to allow for flexible targeted groupings
- Visualizing and Verbalizing
- UFLI and Words Their Way
- Guided Reading Groups

Measures:

- Comprehension -Reading Response Journals, Whiteboard check-ins, Fountas and Pinnell, HLAT, CC3, Observations, Student interviews, Formative and Summative Classroom assessments, Precision Reading
- Skills UFLI Used throughout primary grades K- 2. Ongoing formative and summative assessment Words Their Way, Portfolios of student work, CC3, PAST, LENS, Precision Reading
- Fluency Repeated Readings Tracks students speed and accuracy Writing Stamina observations of the length of time students can spend focused on quality writing, RAN, Precision Reading, Guided reading intervention,

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Goal #2: By June 2026 we will see improved numeracy fluency scores through ongoing formative assessment by explicitly teaching fluency strategies and making connections to curricular outcomes.

Strategies:

- CTM Meetings
- Teaching fluency strategies explicitly through the use of division provided resources
- School wide use and commitment to Jump Math allowing for common vocabulary across all grades
- SNAP and ANIE Tool to identify areas of strengths and weakness
- Weekly teacher led Numeracy intervention blocks for all grades that targets gaps and areas of need
- Math games to be taught and used with all grades to create a collaborative and community based approach to basic math facts
- Number Talk Books

Measures:

- Comprehension -SNAP, Math Related Puzzles, Whiteboard check-ins, EICS,PAT results, number talks. Formative and summative assessment, Jump Math Workbooks, problem solving, SNAP/ANIE,
- **Skills** SNAP, EICS, number talks, Formative and summative assessment, Jump Math Workbooks, Math small group intervention, Whiteboards,
- Fluency EICS, progression through Math Minutes, Formative and summative assessments, Small group interventions, Number talks,
